

29.06.2009 The court ordered to pay Capital Group Erik van Egeraat 2,5 million

Last week the Moscow court accepted the decision of the Arbitration Institute of Stockholm Chamber of Commerce, which obligated to pay Capital Group about € 2,5 million for work in the project "Capital City" in the "Moscow City", which was implemented by him.

Dutch architect has developed a project developer for Russia's complex of two skyscrapers, "Capital City" in the "Moscow-City". But later, Capital Group has decided to finish this project without the participation Egeraat.

In 2007, Erik van Egeraat lodged a lawsuit against Capital Group for the indebtedness recovery of implemented scope of work and compensation for copyright infringement. The suit was sent to the Arbitration Institute of the Stockholm Chamber of Commerce. In March last year the court sustained the claim, given by his office Erick van Egeraat associated architects (EEA), which required to recover from the structure of the Capital Group € 516 thousand principal debt and cost of additional works, € 1,5 mln. Lost benefit, as well as compensation for copyright infringement in the amount of \$ 12.5 million rubles, and court costs, writes Kommersant.
